Dear Parent,

Thank you for signing up your child to participate in the Ridgefield Guild of Artist's Summer Camp Experience. We guarantee that your child will have a fun and creative experience and will make new artistic friends.

Our full day camp starts at 10 a.m and continues until 3 p.m. Please send your child with a lunch, drink and water bottle. The lunchtime activity will consist of walks on the Rail/Trail, trips to the playground, free play and indoor games on rainy days. If everyone agrees, we can have Friday pizza day for an additional cost of \$5. Also, on occasion the ice cream truck visits Halpin Lane for the kid's enjoyment.

Our half day camp is from 10 a.m - 12 noon, or, 1 p.m - 3 p.m. If you would like your child to stay for lunch, or come earlier for the afternoon session, there is a \$10 fee to cover the cost of our added lunchtime helper. We welcome you to consider this option for a fuller art experience.

Please be prompt in dropping off your child. Our teachers will begin on time and your child will not want to miss a minute of this exciting day. Also, be considerate in promptly picking up at noon so that our full day campers can move on to their next activity.

Necessary Rules:

- Upstairs in our artist's studio is a door for an emergency exit only! This exit may not be used for any other purpose.
- No electronic devices of any kind - Ipods, MP3's, cell phones, etc. Cell phones must be turned off until the end of the session day. If you need to reach us, please call us at 438-8863.

All forms must be submitted to us by the start day of your child's camp session. We can email forms to you for a quicker turnaround. This is especially important for us to be prepared immediately with emergency phone numbers and pertinent medical information.
